After reading the Investigation No. A3-2997 J decision of the Disciplinary Counsel, I was disappointed to find that amongst the language dismissing the grievance were several items of determination made by the Supreme Court which seem to give credence to the mischaracterizations made by Attorney Pomerants. I had hoped that as a result of your extensive response and my one-on-one interview, which lasted for more than one hour, the truth would have been made clear.


It is still my opinion that no legal issues were "foisted" from you. The case went through proper protocol and procedure, which is for paperwork to be reviewed by the bailiff before being presented to the judge. After you found the paperwork was not proper, you redirected Attorney Pomerants to myself to further instruct on procedural matters, and prerequisites before again approaching the bench.

I am also still of the opinion that you did not make insulting and demeaning comments towards Attorney Pomerants but rather, Attorney Pomerants was completely out of line in disrespecting you and failing to adhere to instruction. His actions were a very poor display of the deference and respect that should be shown toward a judge.

During my tenure as your Bailiff, it was my pleasure to embrace your guidance and direction which allowed me to present documents to your specifications and general court requirements. I think it is unfortunate that an attorney can disregard your guidance through me, refuse to comply with your direct instructions, and believe that he was insulted and demeaned because he has been appropriately corrected.

I hope that as you continue to require proper and correct presentation of documents and courtroom demeanor, attorneys like Pomerants will not erode the respect and dignity the bench deserves.
