

**According to an affidavit prepared by an eyewitness, 'Sarah', in Squire's courtroom on February 4, 2005, during the Camburn case (see excerpt which follows):**

**"Here is what happened. Right from the get-go, she started ordering around the court reporter to write down unnecessary information. There was a brief exchange of words and the recorder left in a huff. This is when it happened. Susan got out her cell phone and started calling someone. The judge told her several times to get off the phone, but she did not listen. In fact, Susan kept on talking, even when she was threatened to be thrown out of court. Finally, the judge put Susan in contempt of court."**
